Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith. The High Court will be pleased to direct the respondent police to trace and secure the petitioners ex-wife Vijayamma Voora and his minor son Aditya.

ORDER: This Petition coming on for hearing on this day in the presence of Mr. K. Govi Ganesan Advocate for the petitioner, and of Mr. A. Saravanan, Government Advocate, on behalf of the respondents, the Court made the following order:-

It is seen that for the reasons stated in the above petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondent police to trace and secure his wife Mrs. Vijaysree Voora and his minor son Aditya. The third respondent herein is present before this Court. Mr. A. Saravanan, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), on instructions from the third respondent, submits that inspite of best efforts taken by the third respondent, the whereabouts of Mrs. Vijaysree Voora and minor son Aditya could not be located. All the leads furnished by the petitioner have been tapped but the whereabouts could not be traced.

2. Mr. Govi Ganesan, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that F.B.I of U.S.A has caused a publication in the following terms:

" Wanted by the FBI,
International Parental Kidnapping
Vijayasree Voora "

The Publication contains the photograph of Mrs. Vijaysree Voora and all the personal details about her and the minor son Aditya. He therefore submitted that since their whereabouts could not be located, the third respondent may be directed to cause publication of a notice in the newspapers in the local area and other Metropolitan Cities. He further submitted that proper publication may be caused through Doordarshan.

3. Considering the aforesaid submission and considering the facts and circumstances of the case and as the whereabouts of Mrs. Vijaysree Voora and her minor son Aditya could not be traced, the third respondent is hereby directed to take all possible steps to secure them. The third respondent is permitted to cause publication of a notice in the newspapers in the local area and other Metropolitan Cities and cause proper publication through Doordarshan.

4. The petitioner shall co-operate with the third respondent in all his efforts to trace his wife Mrs. Vijaysree Voora and his minor son Aditya.

5. Post the matter on 18.01.2008.
